UK MANUFACTURER'S INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION version 6.0 – READ CAREFULLY BEFORE USE

Thank you for selecting this article. You have chosen an item of COFRA workwear.

This item bears the CE mark since it conforms to the regulations set out by REGULATION (EU) 2016/425 on personal protective equipment and repealing Directive 89/686/EEC and satisfies the requirements of the European harmonised standards EN ISO 13688:2013.

All materials used comply with Directive 79/769/EEC "[...] relating to restrictions on the marketing and use of certain dangerous substances and preparations" and subsequent modifications. This article has been manufactured to provide adequate protection for the wearer in the conditions for which it has been designed. The clothing features are shown on the pictogram with the relative symbols on the CE marking and all of these have been thoroughly tested during the development of the product.

DPI HARMLESS – This garment has been made so that it causes no risk to the wearer. The raw materials have been carefully selected to offer the best performance and the longest wear life. There are no parts (e.g. stitching or accessories in direct contact with the skin) which could cause irritation to the wearer.

FITTING TO THE USERS BODY TYPE AND SIZE – The products are made in a size range to cater for most people. If correctly fitted should provide comfort and protection together with freedom of movement.

PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT – trousers can be equipped (if provided with a pocket) with a safe knee made of soft material, suitable when working on knees; it does not protect from impacts, but it offers a comfortable support to knees.

The jackets and coats "e-care" marked are provided with a pocket for a mobile phone. This is lined with a special fabric to give some protection from electromagnetic waves.

FABRIC COMPOSITION – See the fabric label stitched on the garment.

RECOMMENDED USE – Garment with a simple design to protect against risk of slight damage and injury:

- Slight injury caused by mechanical instruments;
- Slight injury caused by cleaning products;
- Risks deriving from heat contact (temperature not above 50°C);
- Slight impacts and vibrations;
- Damaging action of sunlight;
- Ordinary weather conditions during professional activities (EN ISO 13688:2013)

THE GARMENT DOES NOT PROTECT AGAINST:

- Risk from moving parts;
- Risk from chemical aggression (acids, solvents etc.);
- Risk of mechanical aggression (cuts, perforation etc);
- Risk of cut from mobile chainsaw;
- Thermal risk;
- Risk of passing through flame or fire fighting;
- Any other risk for which the jacket is not certified.

NOTICE – The user having evaluated all possible risks should consider combining the garment with other protective devices for protection of all parts of the body. The garment performance is guaranteed when it is correctly worn and fitted.

During the life of the garment it should be inspected regularly to see if it is fit to continue to be used or should be replaced.

This informative note must be retained throughout the whole life of the garment. No change to the PPE can be made. Any modification may invalidate its use. COFRA S.r.l. will not be responsible for damages to persons or articles caused by unauthorised modifications nor decay in performance for which the garment has been designed and certified.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS – It is recommended that the symbols on the labels on the garment be examined carefully. The instructions must be followed as wrong treatment may alter the garments performance. Keep the garments in a dry place away from excessive light and heat sources. COFRA S.r.l. declines all responsibility for improper use or wrong care and maintenance of the garment.

WARNING: do not iron the reflex inserts.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS – Please consider only those quoted on the care instructions labels inside the garment.

LEGEND	Mild treatment: in addition to the basic symbols, a bar under the symbol means that the treatment should be more mild than indicated by the same symbol without a bar, e.g. reduced agitation	- Tumble drying possible - Drying at lower temperature	Ironing at low temperature (max 110 °C)
Maximum temperature: 30 °C	Very mild treatment: in addition to the basic symbols, a double bar under the symbol describes a very mild process, e.g. much reduced agitation	- Tumble drying possible - Normal temperature	Ironing at middle temperature (max 150 °C)
Maximum temperature: 40 °C	Bleaching allowed only in cold water and using a diluted solution	Dry on a horizontal surface	Ironing at high temperature (max 200 °C)

Do not wash	Dry in a vertical position while the product is still full of water, without squeezing and/or spinning	Do not iron	

MARKING – The CE marking is placed inside the garment and stitched to be visible.

It shows: manufacturer's name and logo, model, commercial code, CE logo, category, pictogram/s showing classes and performances of the garment, sizes, maximum number of washes the garment can resist to without prejudice to its performance, fabric composition, maintenance symbols.
